In the mid-2000s, Rockland County was in need of a new water supply based on population growth and expansion. In addition to protecting and ensuring a long term water supply for the future, conservation programs can cost up to \$5 million less than developing and constructing an alternate water supply. When a public service commission called for a state mandated conservation system, SUEZ teamed up with Rockland County to initiate the first program of its kind based primarily on appliance rebates. This program also left room for additional infrastructure investment to reduce leakages.

Since the program began in 2017 (open to residential, multi-family, and non-residential customers), over 1,700 rebates were redeemed. Non-residential customers also qualified for additional rebates for appliances like commercial toilets, urinals, and pre-rinse spray valves. Through our partnership

with the Rockland County business community, we were able to combine instant energy and water saving rebates through local retail stores.

We also offer indoor and outdoor water audits to our customers, to assess the levels of water use in their home, and receive fixture replacements and maintenance recommendations. With each audit, we can make our customers more aware of their water use and help take steps to conserve more in the future. The combination of these programs often has a return on investment of 1-2 years, and saves them money on water bills for years to come.
